

# What is new in May 2024?




#### SATURDAY MORNING GP & NURSE CLINICS



We are now able to offer additional GP, Nurse and Advanced Clinical Practitioner appointments on a Saturday morning, rotating across all four Modality Mid Sussex practice locations. The introduction of additional weekend clinics is the first phase in the redesign of our appointment system. The appointments provided will be a combination of routine and acute care, with the aim to increase capacity and offer more choice for patients.

#### **HOW ARE THESE APPOINTMENTS BOOKED?**

Each weekday Saturday GP routine appointments are released in advance, together with the ability to book routine nurse appointments. A small proportion of the Saturday GP appointments are reserved for the Duty Doctor team to use for patients that need a face to face clinical assessment within 24 hours. This is to help reduce the need to re-direct patients to other NHS services if capacity is reached on a Friday afternoon.



#### **NEW PRACTICE WEBSITE**

In the next few weeks, we will be launching a new practice website provided by iAtro, an award winning GP website provider. Our new website will be more user friendly and accessible for patients. We will be sharing further information in practice and on social media before the website is launched.

#### **NEW PATIENT ACCESS SYSTEM**

Across Modality Partnership, a large number of our practices have adopted new patient access systems, which offer greater flexibility and improve access for patients. Together with redesigning our appointment system, this is something that Modality Mid Sussex is beginning to explore.
